St Andrew's Church - Worship Service Reopening Plan

Dearly beloved in Christ, Worship Services will resume in church starting from Sunday, 6th September, 2020.

- **Sunday 6th September:** Joint Worship Service at 9.00 am with the celebration of the Lord's Supper (Holy Communion). Temperature screening will begin from 8:30 am.
- **From 13th September:** Kannada Service 8:00 am, English Service at 9:30 am,
- These Services will be livestreamed online through social media

Participation:

The below are the guidelines that have been laid out for your safety:

1. Temperature screening will begin from 7:30 am for Kannada Service starting at 8am, and 9:00 am for English Service beginning at 9:30 am.
2. For the celebration and participation in the Lord's Supper, sealed individual communion wafers and wine will be distributed.
3. All the members participating in the service need to wear a face mask all through the Worship Service and also outside the church premises.
4. Kindly note the church would be sanitized before and after each worship service, as per Government norms.
5. Participating members should follow Government prescribed social distancing guidelines while seated inside the church.
6. Guidelines on sanitization need to be followed both while entering and exiting the church.
7. There will be no opportunity for fellowship gathering before or after the service.
8. Request members not to carry any bags or books into church premises.
9. Offering / Self Denial and other contributions can be dropped in the Offertory Box placed at the exits.
10. Please carry your own water bottles.
11. Please keep praying, as we begin our Worship Services on 6th September, 2020 with a Joint Worship Service which will be live streamed online.
12. The church will remain open for personal prayers all through the week and for Wedding and private Baptism Services with government norms.
13. Your health and well being is our primary concern and seeking your sincere cooperation and understanding.
