From the Presbyter's Desk Fullness of Time

"But when the fullness of time had come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under the law.." (Galatians 4:4)

One of our most loved Christmas Carols, *O Little Town of Bethlehem*, from the pen of one of the most loved preachers, *Phillips Brooks*, echoes the ideas of the Advent Season:

O little town of Bethlehem, How still we see thee lie! Above they deep and dreamless sleep The silent stars go by: Yet in thy dark streets shineth The everlasting light; The hopes and fears of all the years Are met in thee tonight.

In the last two lines, it talks of the idea of waiting and believing in *God's time,* and aspirations and hope are for many years, fulfilled in the birth of Jesus Christ in Bethlehem.

Apostle Paul writes to the early Christian communities in the region of Galatia as the "Fullness of time" (Galatians 4:4). The discussion in Galatians 4:1-7 locates the paradox of waiting in expectation of a better world in freedom and joy, away from the slavery to the seen and unseen things of the world. Paul captures the idea of waiting in a very unique fashion, which is described uniquely in all the four Gospels.

Paul's description of *fullness of time* refers to the completion of the period of God's divine preparation and historical timeline that is fulfilled. A possibility like *Law* helps in introducing humanity to the insufficient choices one has and therefore, *"God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under the law"* (*Galatians 4:4*). God's time was perfect and was in line with the religious, social, political, and cultural expectations, and the experiences of the Jews and the non-Jews or the nations. People who claim to have an identity and people who do not, were both welcome to participate in *God's plan of redemption*.

Each Advent Season we are surrounded by matters that are disheartening or disappointing. We keep telling ourselves or we are told that everything is okay or it will be okay. It is ironical that even as we pray and sing about places in Israel and Gaza during this Season, peace and reconciliation is still not in sight. When we talk or sing of Bethlehem, we are probably missing the point that there are expectations of God's time for the people living there. We fail to overlook human suffering in the midst of spiritual and biblical understandings that maybe prejudiced or one sided. We see evil, stupidity and falsehood at every step in our journeys of faith. It is in this context that this Season will help us to draw us back to trust in God's time and plan, to continue to hope without despair and never to forget that at the end, only God's love can sustain the world around us and among us. It is my desire that as we run through the theme of *"Fulness of time,"* this Season, it will help us to make new beginnings and enable us to *rest in God's sovereign purpose and plan in our lives, and never give up.*

Our prayers go with all the members of the *Pastorate Committee* and *Ministry Leaders* as they provide leadership to all the programs during this Season. It is a matter of joy that we continue to share joy with God's people in *Tubagere*, with the children and community at *St. Andrew's School*, at *Siddapura*, and a special effort is being made to reach out to people from the *State of Manipur* who are away from home and currently reside in Bangalore. Our continuing program of *"Agape,"* will continue to envision support for *peace, reconciliation and rebuilding in Manipur*, and we continue to network in this regard.

It has been exciting to join the *Carollers* since *November 26th,* a move necessitated due to increase in the number of families. We are already overwhelmed by the love, care and hospitality of each family and persons during *Carol Rounds*, and please continue to uphold the Carollers in your prayers.

On behalf of the Pastorate Committee, Staff Team and all our families, we wish each one of you, the Compliments of the Season, a Blessed Christmas and a hopeful and promising New Year 2024!
