From the Presbyter's Desk *Wisdom and Life*

"Does not wisdom call, and does not understanding raise her voice?" (Proverbs. 8:1)

In the words of Cicero (106 BC-43 BC), a Poet, Philosopher and Rhetorician during the period of the Roman Empire observes, *"The function of wisdom is discriminating between good and evil."*

We are moving into the month of *June* with two important observances of celebrating *Student's Sunday* and *Environment Sunday*. Hard to believe that another vacation time has gone by, and as time for a new academic year has dawned, we specially remember and pray for all the students' in different stages of education. In my own memory, though we enjoyed our time of vacation, we used to look forward to a new academic year, especially to see friends and feel the joy of the new classroom, class teachers and books.

The *Book of Proverbs* along with the generally titled poetical books like *Psalms* strictly would fit into the category of *"Wisdom Literature."* Wisdom literature generally focusses on universal human concerns, especially the individual human experiences and the celebration of ordered relationships that lead to success by human standards with divine will.

The foundational idea of *Wisdom* is not limited only to the Genesis account, but extends a vast body of literature like *Wisdom Literature*. Wisdom was meant to engage with the creation as both teacher and the promise of God's presence in the creation. Wisdom transcends human boundaries and overcomes human expectations with the presence of God. Wisdom invites us to revisit our knowledge about God and thereby our relationship with God. In *Proverbs 8:1-11*, there is broad call to celebrate righteous living. For the Wisdom teacher, learning is a life-long experience. In *8:10,* the Wisdom teacher observes, *"Take my instruction instead of silver, and knowledge rather than choice gold."* Wisdom is not hidden from anyone nor can anyone hide it, because it is a gift from God. Wisdom helps us to understand God's creation from a non-hierarchical point of view. Wisdom is visible from everywhere and available to all and to the whole creation irrespective of all human identities both natural or artificial.

It is our prayer that a renewed understanding of Wisdom will help our Children as they embark on another year of academic journey, and in our own life of partnership in sustaining and renewing the Creation. As we come to a close of the *Triennium 2021 - 2024*, I wish to thank the leadership in the Pastorate Committee and the leadership in the Subcommittees and various volunteers who have cooperated in the continuing ministry and mission of our church.

Wisdom from Above (Dedicated to our students)

Peer pressure is a commonly used term these days. The Old Testament tells the story of another kind of peer pressure. David and his men were hiding from Saul in a cave when Saul entered (1 Samuel 24). David's companions suggested that God had delivered Saul to them, and they urged David to kill him. But David refused to harm Saul because he was "the Lord's anointed" (v 6).

People in our lives may sometimes suggest we do what seems most gratifying or practical in the moment. But there is a difference between worldly and spiritual wisdom (1 Corinthians 2:6-7). Wisdom from above "is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy" (James 3:17). When others are urging us to take a certain course of action, we can invite God to influence our response. **One is truly wise who gains his wisdom from above**.
