From the Presbyter's Desk



Mission: An Open Door

"... Look, I have set before you an open door, which no one is able to shut ..." (Revelation 3: 8)

One of the most understood and at the same time misunderstood words has been "Mission." The participation and observance of the 'Mission Month', has been one of the meaningful seasons at our church. Even as we prepare to celebrate the Mission Month, I am excited about the poetic imagination of *Elizabeth Barrett Browning* (1806-1861):

"Earth's crammed with heaven, And every common bush afire with God; But only he who sees, takes off his shoes; The rest sit round it and pluck blackberries."

The message of Jesus Christ to the *Seven Churches* in the *Book of Revelation* continues to draw us closer to experience the favour of God. The sixth of Christ's messages to the Seven Churches in Asia Minor (Modern Turkey), is to the *Church in Philadelphia (Revelation 3:7-13)*. One of the important theological statements discussed in carrying out God's Mission in our time and in our own context, is the image of the "Open Door" (Revelation 3:8).

The word *Philadelphia literally* means "brotherly love" (Hebrews 13:1). The small Church in Philadelphia displayed much love and loved the work of God's grace in one another, and considered one another higher than themselves. The spirit of love was evident in their daily social life as a community. When Christ introduces his message in 3:7, He lists three reasons: Holiness of Christ, truthfulness of Christ and the power of Christ. Fulfilling the words of the Prophet Isaiah (Isaiah 22:22), it is Christ who opens and no one will shut, and who shuts and no one opens (Revelation 3:7).

The "Open Door," is a sign of God's favour; for us today, it is 'Opportunity.' This is a door of usefulness, service and witness of the Gospel. It is an opportunity for us to share the Good News in our families, neighbours and all whom we interact with. An open door is an opportunity to experience and share the message of salvation.

When Paul and Barnabas returned from their missionary journey and reported to the Community, they rejoiced that God "had opened the door of faith." (Acts 14:27). The Apostle Paul talks about the opportunity in Troas to proclaim the good news of Christ and says, "a door was opened for me in the Lord" (2 Corinthians 2:12).

The idea of "Open Door," in Missions is a reminder that God's mission is not just about concepts, methods, or strategies, but it lies in the favour of God in Jesus Christ and our willingness to see opportunities around us, as Christ sees it.

It is our prayer that this year, God will provide new opportunities and help us envision new possibilities to participate in God's mission. We thank God for our continuing work at *Tubagere village*, and the community of faith who have sustained in the midst of many challenges. Our prayers and support continue to make a difference in the lives of the people at Tubagere. With a new leadership team, it is our hope that the good work of many years will continue and be blessed.

We thank God for the new leadership in the *Pastorate Committee*, and it is a matter of joy that almost all the *Sub-committees* have met and discussed about each ministry and the continuing short and long-term visions for the present and the future. We hope to share these ideas very soon for your continuing prayers and support. The meetings of the Staff to complement the work of the leadership continues with the same rigor and we are doing our best to improve from your feedback and learnings. Please take the liberty to share ideas and suggestions, as we grow together as a community. 
