From the Presbyter's Desk



Growing in Freedom

"...keep sound wisdom and prudence, and they will be life for your soul..."

(Proverbs 3:21-22)

We have probably heard this, "To look at is one thing; To see is another. To understand is a third. To learn from what you understand is still something else. But to act on what you learn is what really matters."

October is a month that continues to help us to remember one of the most significant movements in Modern Church History, *The Protestant Reformation*, that altered the religious, social, cultural and political map of Europe, and in many ways, of the world. One of the key ideas of the *Reformation Movement* is the idea of *"Freedom,"* which found its place in the writings of reformers like *Martin Luther, John Calvin* and others, and which started a new movement of *Christian education and teaching,* and which opened up the modern *Sunday School movement* in most protestant churches as a mainstream ministry.

The passage in *Proverbs 3:19-24*, brings us back to the foundational Christian faith in understanding God as the Creator of the earth and the heavens (*Proverbs 3:19*). Wisdom as a tradition in the Bible helps us understand that we live in a world ordered by God, and the principles of wisdom is built into the structure of the world. Wisdom is to believe that there is freedom in order rather than in chaos. Freedom is living with God in a world ordered by God and not living without God, a freedom that is not real freedom and temporary. Wisdom is a gift which drops down like the 'dew' (*Proverbs 3:20*), an image that helps that God refreshes and restores the earth and our lives. One of the greatest contributions of the reformation movement is to provide us the freedom to open and read *God's Word*, which reveals *God's Love*.

Even as we think of our children and celebrate ministry among Children, introducing them to the idea of freedom and helping them to grow in freedom, will continue to be a priority for us. Let the spirit of Reformation continue to help us to celebrate freedom for others and for ourselves.

St. Andrew's Church Music School



St. Andrew's Church, long known for its rich musical heritage, had always deserved a *Music School* of its own. Despite several attempts, it had not materialized - until the Pastorate Committee revitalized the idea and re-launched the Music School in 2015.

Initially, piano and violin lessons were offered to both members of our church and other congregations. Finding teachers proved challenging, as students preferred weekend classes, and many professional musicians were already committed. Nevertheless, the school officially started in 2016. Since then, numerous students - both young and not-so-young - have had the opportunity to learn violin, keyboard, cello, and trumpet at a nominal fee. Many have been successfully groomed to pass the Grade Exams from both the ABRSM (Associated Board of the Royal Schools of Music, London) https://www.abrsm.org/en-in and Trinity College of Music, London, https://www.trinitycollege.com/gualifications/ often achieving distinction.

The school continues to grow, and efforts are ongoing to introduce additional classes and instruments based on demand. Furthermore, the voice training classes - wonderful initiative by the *late Mr. Godfrey Ayyadurai* and now ably sustained by *Mrs. Neha Soans George* - are further enhancing music education at our church.

Currently, violin, keyboard, and guitar lessons are expertly led by seasoned teachers *Mr. Peter Appaji* and *Mr. Sujan Das*. On Sunday, 22nd September 2024, it was a true joy to hear their students perform an *Instrumental Ensemble* during the *Kannada Service*. They played "Seek Ye First the Kingdom of God" by Karen Lafferty, skilfully blended with *Johann Pachelbel's* timeless *Canon in D* as interludes, creating a beautiful fusion of contemporary and classical music.

Education and Professional Networking Committee (EPNC)



On the First Sunday of September, the EPNC Team conducted a Session on 'Government Welfare and Support Programs for the Christian Community'. The resource person for the Session was Mr. Anthony K (Vikram), Director, Karnataka Minorities Development Corporation (KMDC).

The Key Highlights from the Session are:

- Scholarships & Education Loans: Information was provided on applying for scholarships and overseas education loans up to ₹20 lakhs with 0% interest, available to students securing at least 60% in their UG/PG courses.
- Self-Employment Schemes: Loans up to ₹50,000 with 50% subsidies were available for women entrepreneurs, alongside subsidies for auto and taxi purchases.
- Eligibility & Documentation: Participants were guided on eligibility criteria, required documents like Caste and Income Certificates, and the use of online portals and Nabakacheri for applications.

This Session provided valuable insights into accessing financial aid and selfemployment opportunities, empowering community members to make use of government schemes effectively.

Career Hub:

The Career Hub initiative, driven primarily by *Mr. Yeshwant Panchikal*, has been helping professionals in our community, when they are in-between jobs and makes an impact in their lives. 
