From the Presbyterian's Desk

Joy to the World

But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid; for see, I am bringing you good news of great joy for all the people"
(Luke. 2:10)

Advent is a season that is familiar but we continue to wait, because it is a season that invites us to look beyond the world and its horizons and wait to see new beginnings.

Advent is a season of 'Experience.' Have we paused to ponder the question: *What is it that is coming in the way of experiencing joy in our lives?* Probably we are seeing or meeting someone or living with someone with similar experiences, but the experience of joy is different and unique.

One of the greatest messages of the Christian faith narrated by *Luke* in a key verse in 2:10, highlights one of the greatest truths of the Biblical Story, the greatest event, '*the Messiah is born!*' is told to the Shepherds, a people who were counted as one of the lowest in the social ladder of the society, the last on the social lists. The *Good News* is not exclusive, it makes no distinction, there is no prejudice and it is open to all the people. The Good News is "*Great Joy*," one of the key promises that the Scripture provides during the *Season of Advent*.

The word *Joy* in Greek indicates the idea of experience. Therefore, the *Good News of Joy* was not simply a message to be heard, but a message to be experienced. The first need not be the first, and the last need not be the last, as Jesus taught "*the last will be the first, and the first will be the last*" (*Matthew 20:16*). It means that God's world is shaped by God's design and not merely by human design.

One of the most loved *Hymns*, is *Joy to the World*, by *Isaac Watts*, is based on *Psalms 98*. It is a Hymn that is loaded with literary imagination that even serious scholars of the Bible need to take note of. *Joy to the World* is from his well-known *Hymnal of 1719, Psalms of David, Imitated in the Language of the New Testament*. It was the intention of Watts to give the Psalms a New Testament meaning and style, which in my opinion was original, and the intention of Watts continues to be discussed till date. The words '*Repeat the sounding joy*,' in the Hymn echoes repeatedly our conviction that we worship a God who is righteous, and promises eternal life for all.

Our conversations with our *Leadership Teams* interestingly brought the idea of *Joy* as keynote in this Advent Season. The idea was we need to share our experience of *Joy* to the people who miss it. The result, the program, '*Joy to the Neighbourhood*,' emerged as an initiative from the *Men's Fellowship* to share this *Joy* with people whom we do not know, who are not familiar, and to provide a blanket to people who are homeless in our neighbourhood. Similar initiatives will echo in our programs at St. Andrew's School in Siddapura, our Mission Field in Tubagere, and the outreach programs of our Women's Fellowship, among others. In a similar way, we go with the same experience as *Carollers*, sharing the *Good News of Great Joy* to each home in our church, as we begin *Carol Rounds on St. Andrew's Day*. The *Thanksgiving Offering* we receive will be dedicated to the ministry of St. Andrew's School at Siddapura, this year.

We are all praying earnestly for a *Joy-filled Season of Advent* and a *promising New Year 2025*, and our celebrations begin with the *Celebration of 160 years of God's goodness and faithfulness*, as we celebrate *St. Andrew's Day* this year.

Care For The Elderly

Rev. Sanjay Samuel Ayer spoke about how we all must be grateful for what we have and must thank our *LORD* for giving us all that we have.
